## CARE AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAINTED SURFACES

### USUAL CLEANING:

It is sufficient to clean with soapy water or common detergents to remove most of the stains and dirt that can deposit on the surface. In particular gel, liquid or spray detergents used with a soft cloth are recommended, taking then care to rinse and dry the surface very well to avoid the accumulation of dirt and limescale.

For detergents whose potential aggressiveness is unknown, it is advisable to carry out an application test in a small area that is not visible before using the product.

### RECOMMENDED PRODUCTS:

The following products can be used for routine cleaning:

Ace cream gel

Glassex

Vetril

Classic Viakal

Bleach diluted

Ammonia diluted

With a soft sponge, microfibre cloth or magic eraser.

After cleaning, immediately rinse and dry the surface very well to avoid the formation of halos.

### HOW TO PREVENT DAMAGES:

The surface has a good resistance to stains in general, nevertheless avoid contact with aggressive chemical products such as:

Acetone

Ethyl Alcohol

Trichlorethylene

Strong acids or bases

Thinners

Degreasers

Products to unclog drains

Abrasive detergents

For detergents whose potential aggressiveness is unknown, it is advisable to carry out an application test in a small area that is not visible before using the product.

Avoid contact with highly coloring substances such as ink, cosmetics and dyes

Avoid prolonged contact with surface cleaners

Do not use metal scrapers, iron brushes, blades, cutter or other tools, also avoid the use of abrasive detergents with micro granules, abrasive sponges and abrasive paper that can scratch the surface.

Avoid impacts and falling objects,.

Avoid thermal stress to the product : do not use boiling water (above 55°C-130°F) and do not pour hot oils or liquids on the surface.

Do not place hot objects, cigarettes or open flames on the surface.

Do not use direct hot steam to clean the surface.
